Brief Explanation:

The University of California (UC) requires high schools and/or school districts to annually update their UC ‘a–g’ Course Lists to accurately reflect the ‘a–g’ courses that each school site will offer in the next academic school year. As in previous years, all high schools’ UC ‘a–g’ Course Lists will be updated centrally through a districtwide submission. High schools should not make any changes to their individual site ‘a–g’ lists; these changes must be effected through the Office of Secondary Schools.

Action: All district high schools with established UC ‘a–g’ Course Lists are asked to print, review, and complete the 2016–17 UC ‘a–g’ Course List documents as described in Attachment 1 and return them by **Monday, May 2, 2016**, to Karen Wilson, Planning Analyst, Office of Secondary Schools, Room 2005, Eugene Brucker Education Center.

2016-17 UC 'A-G' COURSE LIST UPDATE INSTRUCTIONS

OVERVIEW

The UC 'a-g' Course List is an academic-year-specific record of individual high school's UC 'a-g' course offerings, published annually by the University of California. It is used to verify the accuracy of coursework reported on students' college-admissions applications and is the backdrop against which individual student achievement is judged. Only courses that are on a school's UC 'a-g' Course List for the year in which they were taken count in the university admissions process.

The University of California requires all high schools and/or school districts to update their UC 'a-g' Course Lists annually to reflect the courses they will be offering the following year. In the district, this update is done centrally on behalf of all high schools based on information provided in the UC 'a-g' Course List update documents attached to this circular.

ACTION REQUIRED

Principals are asked to complete and return the following 2016-17 UC 'a-g' Course List update documents to Karen Wilson, Planning Analyst, Office of Secondary Schools, Room 2005, Eugene Brucker Education Center, **by Monday, May 2, 2016:**

Attachment 2—Principal Certification Form

A signed Principal Certification Form must accompany the site's updated 2016-17 UC 'a-g' subject-area course worksheets (described below) when they are returned. Principals are responsible for ensuring the accuracy of the information reported on their school's annual UC 'a-g' Course List; by signing this certification form, they acknowledge they have reviewed the updated course information and agree that it should be submitted as their school's official 2016–17 UC 'a-g' Course List.

Attachment 3—UC 'a-g' Subject-Area Course Worksheets

The seven subject-area (one for each 'a-g' subject) and one Advanced Placement (AP) course worksheets reflect schools' 2015-16 course choices for their UC 'a-g' lists. These choices must be updated for the 2016–17 school year by removing courses that won't be offered and adding any new 'a-g' courses that are planned. Because UC 'a-g' Course Lists are meant to be year-specific records of the course opportunities available to students at their individual high school, your updated worksheets should include only the 'a-g' courses that appear in your site's master schedule for 2016-17.

To update your worksheets, please follow the process outlined on the next page.

UPDATING THE 2016-17 'A-G' SUBJECT-AREA COURSE WORKSHEETS

GENERAL

- a.) All 'a-g' courses currently approved for the 2016-17 school year are listed on the worksheets, with the exception of online Edgenuity courses offered by iHigh Virtual Academy. Please do not write in the title of a course that isn't on the worksheets, since it can't be added to your 'a-g' list.
- b.) All worksheets should be printed out and revised using a red or blue pen. The name of your school should appear at the top of each worksheet.
- c.) Do not add or delete any 'x's' in the grid. All changes should be noted in the left-hand margin next to the course number and title as described further on.

LIMITATIONS

Certain courses require permission before they can be added to a school's 'a-g' list. These include:

Career Technical Education (CTE) Courses

All Career Technical Education courses have a "(CTE)" notation in their course title line on the worksheets. The Office of College, Career, and Technical Education (CCTE) must approve all requests to add a new CTE course to a school 'a-g' list. Schools planning to add one or more of these courses to their 2016-17 lists should have the CCTE Office confirm permission by emailing Karen Wilson at kwilson2@sandi.net.

Site-Adopted Courses

Courses that have been designated site-adopted may only be offered by sites that have received Board approval to do so. These courses and the sites approved to offer them are clearly identified on the worksheets. Schools not already approved to offer a site-adopted course must obtain Board approval via the Interdivisional Curriculum Committee (ICC) before the course can be put on their 'a-g' list. Information about the ICC can be found on the district web site under the Office of Secondary Schools.

Advanced Placement (AP) Courses

All AP courses must be approved and/or reauthorized annually through the College Board's AP Course Audit process to be included on a school's UC 'a-g' list. To ensure their placement on schools' 2016-17 'a-g' lists, all AP courses must be audit approved by September 6, 2016. An audit-assigned syllabus number is now required to add an AP course to a site's UC course list.

UPDATING THE WORKSHEETS

1. Print out the eight sets of worksheets in Attachment 3 and review them for accuracy. They should reflect all 'a-g' courses being taught at your site this year and not include courses that aren't being offered. Note any discrepancies you find and whether they need to be corrected on your 2016-17 list.
2. Compare the information on the worksheets to your site's published 2015-16 UC 'a-g' Course List, which can be accessed from here <http://www.ucop.edu/agguide/>. Again, note any discrepancies and if they need to be corrected for your 2016-17 list.

3. Update all worksheets to reflect the courses your school will offer in 2016–17.

a.) If no course changes are needed on a worksheet page, write “No Change” or “NC” at the top of the page and circle it.

b.) Record all course changes you want to effect in the left-hand margin of the worksheet next to the course number and title in the following manner:

On the ‘a-g’ subject-area worksheets— To add a course to your 2016-17 ‘a-g’ list, circle the course number and course title on the worksheet and write ‘A’ in the margin next to it. To remove a course that will no longer be taught at your site next year, put a line through the course number and title, and write ‘D’ in the margin next to it.

On the AP course worksheet—For existing AP course offerings that you plan to reauthorize for the 2016-17 school year, put an ‘R’ in the left-hand margin next to the course number and title. For new AP courses you plan to offer in 2016–17, put an ‘N’ next to the course number and title. New AP courses include any AP course that was not taught at your site in 2015-16, and any AP course assigned to a teacher who has not previously taught it.

4. Review the changes, sign and attach the Principal Certification Form, and send the completed documents via school mail to Karen Wilson.

IMPORTANT DEADLINES

March 1, 2016—AP Course Audit web site begins accepting syllabi submissions for new AP courses that schools plan to offer in the 2016-17 school year.

May 2, 2016—Deadline for schools to submit **their** updated 2016-17 ‘a-g’ Course List worksheets to Karen Wilson.

June 30, 2016—Deadline for teachers of new AP courses to submit their syllabi to the AP Audit web site to ensure they’re approved in time to be added to sites’ 2016-17 UC ‘a-g’ Course Lists.

Aug. 1, 2016—Principals begin renewing previously authorized AP courses through the AP Audit web site that their school will offer in 2016-17.

Sept. 6, 2016—Deadline for schools to have AP Audit approval for all new and renewed AP courses they will be offering to ensure they get on the school’s 2016-17 UC ‘a-g’ Course List.

Sept. 15, 2016—Deadline for all 2016-17 UC ‘a-g’ Course List changes to be entered into the UC system.

Information on completing this year’s AP Course Audit process will provided in a separate Administrative Circular from the Office of Secondary Schools.
