- Action Requested:**
1. Ensure all students currently enrolled in World Language Courses in grade 9–12 receive the information on the SDUSD Seal of Biliteracy.
 2. Ensure that all 12th grade students who have taken or are currently enrolled in World Language courses receive the application form for the SDUSD Seal of Biliteracy.
 3. Ensure that school counselors work with students to review the application and determine eligibility for receiving the SDUSD Seal of Biliteracy Award by carefully reviewing student transcripts, AP or IB Exam scores, End of Course Honors 7-8 scores, or SAT II World Language scores.

Brief Explanation:

SDUSD Seal of Biliteracy is an academic recognition for high school graduating seniors who have attained proficiency in two or more languages. The SDUSD Seal of Biliteracy is directly

linked to the Language Learning Policy adopted by the San Diego Unified School District Board of Trustees in August of 2009, which recognizes that “in addition to being academically prepared and fully proficient in English, all students benefit from being proficient in another language”. In addition, attainment of the SDUSD Seal of Biliteracy by graduating seniors clearly advances tenets of the District’s Vision 2020 plan for “preparing our students for the competitive global economy they will face in the years ahead” and the Vision 2020 goal to ensure that “students from all backgrounds in our district develop the ability to communicate in two languages.” Qualifying students graduating in the spring/summer of 2018 will receive SDUSD Seal of Biliteracy.

The State Seal of Biliteracy, AB 815, was signed by the governor and enacted into the California Education Code on October 8, 2011 and amended in 2017 AB 1142. As more information becomes available from the California Department of Education, revisions and alignment to the district criteria for the Seal of Biliteracy may be warranted.

Eligibility Criteria:

The student application form explains the specific criteria that must be met and documented in order for students to fulfill the requirements for the SDUSD Seal of Biliteracy.
